

AGREEMENT
for
ACADEMIC COOPERATION AND EXCHANGE
between
GRADUATE SCHOOL OF SOCIAL WELFARE, TOYO UNIVERSITY
and
COLLEGE OF HUMANITIES AND SOCIAL SCIENCES, CHAOYANG UNIVERSITY OF
TECHNOLOGY

(Parties and Effect)

Article 1: Graduate School of Social Welfare, Toyo University in Japan and College of Humanities and Social Sciences, Chaoyang University of Technology in Taiwan have entered into this Agreement in recognition of the mutual benefits accruing to their academic communities from the establishment of strong international links.

(Purpose)

Article 2: The purpose of this Agreement is to contribute toward the development of research and education of both institutions through their academic collaboration.

(Scope of Agreement)

Article 3: For the purpose of this Agreement, the general areas of interest to partners are collaboration and exchange of knowledge in the areas of common interest as follows:

- 1) Exchange of faculty members and students for study and research;
- 2) Execution of joint research projects;
- 3) Exchange of information and academic publications; and
- 4) Other programs acceptable to both parties.

(Publications)

Article 4: All works, publication or publicity related to the present agreement shall state the collaboration between two parties and should include at least one author from each party.

(Responsibility for Costs)

Article 5: Financial arrangements for collaborative activities will be agreed upon on a case-by-case basis.

(Laws and Regulations involved)

Article 6: Activities conducted under this Agreement shall be subjected to the laws and regulations of the respective countries and of international law.

(Validation Period)

- Article 7: 1) This Agreement will become effective from the date when the signatories representing both faculties have affixed their signatures to it, and shall be valid for an initial period of five years.
- 2) This Agreement shall be automatically extended for another five years unless either partner gives written notice of termination to the other party no later than six months before the expiry date, and the same rule shall apply thereafter.

(Revision)

- Article 8: 1) This agreement shall be amendable by mutual negotiation, six months prior to the expiration, when the amendment is based upon the proposals made by the representatives of either party.
- 2) The revised agreement shall come into effect on the day of its signature by representatives of both parties.
- 3) Should any of the activities specified in Article 3 be affected by an amendment of the Agreement, the Agreement prior to amendment shall continue to apply to those activities.

(Termination)

Article 9: This Agreement may be terminated by either party giving written notice of termination to the other party not less than six months before the expiry date.

(Original Document Protection)

Article 10: This Agreement is signed in two copies in English. Each party to the Agreement shall retain one copy.
